Data from the NCH must be acknowledged whenever it is used, in the manner specified by the NCH division (but not in any way that suggests that the NCH endorses you or your use of the work).

'Data' means and includes:

supplied to you via the Natural and Cultural Heritage Values (NCH) Division of the Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment (DPIPWE).

The NCH division utilises the Creative Commons Attribution 3.0 Australia (CC Aus.) licences for selected Data. The CC Aus. Licence advises the permitted use of the Data. Data uses permitted can be different, please refer to the CC Aus. Licence. Regardless of the CC Aus. licence used you must always attribute the NCH as the creator.
